We meet once a month and had our Inaugural Committee Meeting formed by
“Friends of Lyell Deer Farm” 14th. November 2008. and Incorporated 2nd. June 2009

Indigenous people and other Cultural groups can interconnect by sharing ceremonies,
music, wisdom and knowledge.
This will be a place of peace and harmony and a sanctuary for local wildlife.

From The Lyell Deer Farm we have leased a 10acre block of land protected under the
State Government (E.P.A) Environmental Protection Act as a Rare Eco Region. with
‘Land for Wildlife Accreditation’ which will be kept in its natural state for generations to
come .

In 2005 the land was blessed by Aboriginal Elder Tex Chapman Wakka Wakka Tribe
representing the original ancestors of this land, he gave his permission to hold
Multicultural Gatherings to bring together all cultures, to break down the barriers
between Nations. He could see many Gatherings of all Nations on this Land.

We have named the area “Kupidabin Wilderness” A Place of Peace and Harmony,
Kupidabin is the Aboriginal word for “Place of Possums”
Wilderness (according to the Macquarie Dictionary) A place where the ecology is
undisturbed. A place of isolation away from the centre of things.

In November 2007 we had our first Multicultural Gathering bringing together,
Aboriginal, Maori, Native American and Torres Strait Islanders for the weekend.
Visitors came to our Valley from all areas and the Welcoming Ceremony was enjoyed
and well attended by many local people and their families.

A decision was made by The Council of Elders to make this a Bi-Annual Event.
These Events will be called “Kupidabin Gathering of The Four Winds”

The name was inspired by the book ‘Wisdom of the Four Winds’ written by Barry
Brailsford in New Zealand and the story of ‘The Temple of the Four Winds’.

Kupidabin Association Inc. honours the ancient wisdom present in Australia and seeks to
encourage others to discover their creative source..

The Association aims to : Foster leadership and integrity. Encourage positive change.
Promote understanding among peoples.
